

International Hearing of the Court of Arbitration for Sport



Last April 14th a hearing of the Court of Arbitration for Sport – CAS (based in Lausanne, Switzerland) took place for the first time within the Universidad Austral (Austral University, Argentina).

This Court rules on international lawsuits related to sports, because most of international federations and the International Olympic Committee have contained an arbitration clause in their articles of association that obliges their members to resolve their disputes ultimately in front of CAS.

The hearing was chaired by Efraim Barack, from Israel, and co-arbitrated by Nicolas Ulmer, from Switzerland, and Gustavo Abreu, from Argentina. Yago Vázquez, from Barcelona, acted as Ad Hoc Clerk and supervised all proceedings by the CAS Legal Counsel, Antonio de Quesada, from Peru.
